## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM WILL CONTINUE**

The Chapter Scholarship scholarship program began during the 1969-1970 school year. The program was proposed and initiated by then Chapter President Jack Hallstrom. We hope to award a similar number of scholarships to those granted during the 2008-2009 school year.

Scholarships are funded by contributions from members. You will have an opportunity to purchase raffle tickets for the entire year at the September meeting. We urge you to participate in this project.

During the 2008-2009 year we also were awarded \$500.00 from PDK International to use for one of our scholarships granted to a student planning to become a teacher. Our chapter received these funds because we had made the largest contribution to the PDK International Foundation in Region B during the previous year. \$600.00 was also added to the scholarship fund in 2008-2009 from proceeds received from the golf outing that was a part of the chapter's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration.

We hope you will also contribute at least \$10.00 to the PDK International Foundation at the September meeting to help assure we continue to receive the \$500.00 award for the most contributions made to the fund from any chapter in Region B.

In 2008-2009 \$500.00 scholarships were presented to Nicholas Passarelli, Millard West, son of member Angelo Passarelli; Rachel Curry, a graduate of Bellevue West and a UNO Elementary Education Major; Robin Dahlke, a graduate of Papillion LaVista South and a UNO Secondary Education Major, and Carol Fowler, a UNO Secondary Education Major. \$200.00 Showcase of Teaching scholarships were awarded to Amanda Brooke Fitch, Burke; and Brittany Lynn Cheney, Council Bluffs Abraham Lincoln.

Carol Fowler received the Del Weber Scholarship. This award is named in honor of former longtime UNO Chancellor Del Weber. The scholarship is awarded to a minority student who is in the teacher education program at UNO. The purpose of the award is to provide support for minority students who wish to become teachers. Carol wrote the following note in appreciation for receiving the scholarship:

*I am writing to thank you for selecting me to receive the Del Weber Scholarship for 2009. It is a great honor to receive it, and I am humbling by your gracious act.*

*I will begin student-teaching at Central High School in August 2009. I have been going to classes and driving a school bus for the past few years. I am excited to have the opportunity to get into a classroom and begin my career. It has been a challenge to work, to care for my family, and to remain in school. I am very happy that I have been able to come to this point.*
